  - (a) inspect and make copies of the statement of accounts prepared by the Authority;
  - (b) inspect and make copies of the auditor's certificate that the audit of the Authority's accounts including that statement has been completed;
  - (c) inspect and make copies of the auditor's opinion on the statement of accounts;
  - (d) inspect and make copies of any such any public interest report relating to the Authority;
  - (e) inspect and make copies of any recommendation relating to the Authority.
