§ Fostering Payments and Allowances



In April, payments and allowances for our in-house foster carers rose by **6.88%**!

The minimum weekly allowance for a foster carer has increased to £170 per week, with the maximum weekly allowance going up to £249 per week.

Additional weekly skill fees, paid in recognition of our carers' skills, experience and dedication to continuous learning and development, have also increased.

Wendy and William live in Leicestershire and have been fostering for over **30 years**. During this time, they have fostered **22 babies**, adopted two young people, and raised two birth children.

They estimate that they have sterilised approximately 40,000 bottles, changed over 50,000 nappies, and owned over 15 pushchairs!
