## PLANNED RESURFACING WORKS AND TEMPORARY ROAD CLOSURE OF DERBY ROAD, HIGH STREET, CHURCH GATE MARKET PLACE & LONDON ROAD, KEGWORTH.

I write to inform you of forthcoming road works on Derby Road, High Street, Church Gate, Market Place and London Road, Kegworth. The purpose of the works is to resurface and strengthen the carriageway as well as associated civils works and reinstating roadmarkings once the surfacing is complete.

The programme of works are as follows (weather permitting): Monday 15<sup>th</sup> July – Friday 26<sup>th</sup> July 2024 (not including Sat and Sun). Working times - 07:30hrs to 18:30hrs.

Through traffic will be diverted via a signed diversion and traffic marshals will be in place at strategic locations to give assistance and to control restricted access through the works to residents and businesses directly affected by the closure. While the High Street/Derby Road junction is closed the pedestrian crossing will also be closed. There will be a signed crossing diversion as well as a traffic marshal on hand to help with crossing the site safely.

Please refer to the enclosed plan for the phased closure extents. Outside of these times, and if safe to do so, the roads will be re-opened to traffic.

Bus stop services on Market Place, High Street, and London Road will be directly affected between 7:30am and 6:30pm (Monday to Friday) as well as other stops around the closure, so please check with the bus operator before you travel. For further information please see:

If your property/business is directly affected by the road closure, we will endeavour to provide access during the times mentioned above, although restrictions will need to be in place for long periods of the day for the safety of all road users and the work force.

Please ensure suitable provisions are in place to avoid the restriction between the times stated above.

If you need to leave your property at a specific time, we would ask that you plan to move your vehicle to outside the works area well in advance to prevent delays occurring. If this is not feasible, or you have any specific needs or requirements during the working period specified above, please contact me in advance of the works so we can try and make mutual arrangements to make everything run as smooth as possible. Access to and from the effected properties outside of the working shifts will be available; please ensure care is taken when passing through the working area as there may be uneven surfaces and raised ironworks.

Please be mindful that this construction work will involve the movements of large plant and machinery within the carriageway, including reversing manoeuvres. New road surfaces are very hot when first laid. If you need access through the site either in a vehicle or on a cycle or on foot while work is taking place, please take extra care and be aware of additional hazards. If you are in any doubt as to what to do, please ask the workforce for assistance.

During the construction of the scheme, it is inevitable that some disruption will be caused, and I apologise in advance for any inconvenience.
