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# My child has SEND. I would like to look around. What do I need to do?

If you phone me we can arrange a visit to look around and discuss your child's needs.if you visit my Facebook Page Kim's childminding you will see some of the activities I do with the children.

#### How will my child and I be made to feel welcome and how will you get ready for my child coming?

Once you decide to join my childminding practise I will arrange some settling in visits. These visits will help your child get to know me , the children and the setting. I will ask you to fill out an all about me form and discuss your child's routine and daily needs.

#### How accessible are your premises?

I have a small step at the front of my house .As I live in a terraced house there is only one bathroom upstairs. The toys in the lounge are at child height and accessible to all the children. There is a small step into the kitchen which leads into the garden.The garden is on one level with a range of toys and a playhouse.

#### How will you keep my child safe?

I risk assess my house on a daily basis. If we go out in the car I risk assess the place we are visiting. I have a behavior policy, and a safeguarding policy. My husband, and son have a crb check and my other son and daughter have a DBS check .As I've been childminding since 1998 have been checked by social services. We are all paediatric first aid trained. My last Ofsted was a good. I have forms for addminstrating medicine and an accident/incident book which parents sign when necessary. I make a note of any allergies the children have and discuss diets with the parent.

## How will you communicate with me what my child has done, enjoyed and learnt?

I will provide a daily diary for your child noting what they have been doing during the day. I will also do a learning journey for them full of photos and observations', Alongside a tracker book showing what stage I feel your child is at. I have a Facebook page where you can see your child enjoying different activities . I will text or phone if necessary, sending photos over WhatsApp to reassure if the child has been upset. Though I will always talk to you at drop off and pick up times about anything you feel I need to know for that day.

#### How do you work with other professionals?

I liaise with the preschools and schools. I liaise with other childminders and go on training course's. I have access to pacey where I can talk to professional childcare experts.

## What training have you/your staff had in SEND?

I have 19 years childminding experience, and have my nvq3 in early years child care and education. I have competed several courses with Menphys outreach program. I have a paediatric first aid certificate and epi -pen training. I have had experience looking after children with ADHD, Autism, and speach and language delays.

## How will you adapt play opportunities for my child?

I will discuss with you what your child likes to play with and what strategy works best for your child with regard to getting the best out of them.I will suggest they bring a familiar toy to my setting on the first few visits as reassurance. I will observe your child and make notes on how your child reacts to certain environments so I can provide the best possible play opportunities for them.

## How will you get ready for my child going to his/her new school?

I Will get permission from you to liaise with the school and share information with them. I Will talk to your child about moving to school and visit if possible. I will encourage your child to take their learning journey to school to show their new teacher what they like to do.

How will you and I know how my child is doing and how will you help me to support my child's learning?

Your child's development Will be tracked using a learning journey book and a tracker book. I Will regularly share this with you and talk to you about any concerns that I might have. I will use the information collected through observation to create next steps to bring your child's development on.
