Please contact us and we will arrange a suitable time to visit.

How will my child and I be made to feel welcome and how will you get ready for my child coming?

We will talk with you and find out what your child likes and dislikes to do, we will then ensure that we have some items that will interest them when you come to visit.

How accessible are your premises?

Unfortunately we have to use a staircase which we cannot avoid.

How will you keep my child safe?

We have strict safeguarding procedures and processes in place and will keep you up to date with any changes straight away.

How will you communicate with me what my child has done, enjoyed and learnt?

We will update Tapestry frequently so that you can see what we are doing as well as communicating verbally and by email.

How do you work with other professionals?

We have unfortunately not had the chance for many face to face meetings with other professionals due to Covid, we work very well with others via email, zoom and telephone and look forward to being able to meet up with other professionals as soon as restrictions allow.

What training have you/your staff had in SEND?

Our manager and staff have all worked with children with SEND previously, our manager is currently attending a SENCO training course and is due to start a SEND for managers later this month.

How will you adapt play opportunities for my child?

We have a large array of resources and specific resources for a variety of physical, sensory and emotional needs. Staff are experienced at adapting and extending activities accordingly to suit individual needs.

How will you get ready for my child going to his/her new school?

We will follow a 'school' day much more closely as starting school gets closer, we use a local schools sports facilities and outdoors space so any children moving on to there will be very familiar with their surroundings. We will also liaise closely with the setting where the children will be moving up to and ensure that we are all sharing relevant information clearly.

How will you and I know how my child is doing and how will you help me to support my child's learning?

We will carry out regular assessments and progress reports and communicate clearly with you about these, we will adapt activities and play to help in the areas needed and we will communicate ideas and plans with you on a regular basis.
