How will my child and I be made to feel welcome and how will you get ready for my child coming?

Every person that enters my setting is always made to feel welcome. To prepare for your child coming i will do the appropriate research and talk to the relevant professionals for advice if required.

How accessible are your premises?

Will struggle tp get a wheelchair in and don't have a downstairs toilet

How will you keep my child safe?

I have a safeguarding policy in place which covers the premises,mobile phones ans cameras and suitable people etc

How will you communicate with me what my child has done, enjoyed and learnt?

I keep a daily diary which details all this info and gives the parents the opportunity to complete. I also keep a learning journey which tracks the child's progress.

How do you work with other professionals?

I will conatct them if required for support and advice

What training have you/your staff had in SEND?

I have completed a Menphys Disabled and Young Persons course and also have Cache Level 3 in children and young people However I have an Autistic Child of my own.

How will you adapt play opportunities for my child?

I will adapt the activity to the child depending on their age and stage of development which I will be tracking through EYFS

How will you get ready for my child going to his/her new school?

Will support them in the transition in a no of ways i.e. social stories or picture books

How will you and I know how my child is doing and how will you help me to support my child's learning?

Keep daily diary and learning journal. Can liaise with parents every day or arrange a separate meeting to discuss if required. Will alter activities in accordance with parents requirements
