How will my child and I be made to feel welcome and how will you get ready for my child coming?

We have an open door policy for all parents and their children to come to our Pre-School and meet the staff and setting. We have all the facilities to accommodate children with SEND and have adjacent room which can be used for a more private discussion if required. We are very passionate about providing great early years education to all children regardless of their status.

How accessible are your premises?

We have easy access for wheelchair users along with toilet facilities and our Pre-School is on one level

How will you keep my child safe?

We have stringent safety procedures and safe guarding policies that are in place and are followed on a daily basis. These can be made available on request.

How will you communicate with me what my child has done, enjoyed and learnt?

As part of your child's development, we use a learning journey to capture their work, progress, building targets and is used for review with parents and the child's Key Worker and Manager on a regular basis with a face to face meeting

How do you work with other professionals?

We work with all bodies that support early years foundation establishments, this can range from Local County Council to Health Visitors

What training have you/your staff had in SEND?

The Pre-School Manager has attended a course for SEND in Supporting Young Children with SEND. Along with this, we have a local SEND officer supporting the Pre-School

How will you adapt play opportunities for my child?

These will be reviewed and dependent on the child and tailored to meet their early years requirements

How will you get ready for my child going to his/her new school?

We will work with the local SEND officer along with the Primary School to review the child's needs and requirements for his/her move
